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## FOR ENGLISH

### Question Pattern UG English (B A Hons)

Each paper will have **two** broad divisions. In the **First Unit** there will be three broad questions of 10 marks each. The questions will have to be answered from each component and each component will have two questions out of which one has to be answered. In the **Second Unit** short questions will be set from components where 5 marks have been allotted separately, (i.e.10+5). The short questions will be set together under one section from the said components and out of 10 such questions of 2 marks each, 5 questions will have to be answered. So the question pattern will be like the following:

### Question Pattern UG English (B A Programme)

Each paper will have **two** broad divisions. In the **First Unit** there will be three broad questions of 10 marks each. The questions will have to be answered from each component and each component will have two questions out of which one has to be answered. **Where there are four components of 10 marks, questions will be set from any three components.** In the **Second Unit** short objective type questions will be set from components where 5 marks have been allotted separately, (i.e.10+5). **In case of papers where there are four components of 10 marks each and no separate allotment of 5 marks has been done, short objective type questions will be set from all four components.** The short questions will be set together under one section from the said components and out of 10 such questions of 2 marks each, 5 questions will have to be answered. So the question pattern will be like the following:
