It is unanimously resolved that -

- 1. RAC report is to be submitted after completion of six months on and from the date of publication of Ph. D. course work result. However, if any research scholar joins the Ph. D. programme of this university after completion of Ph. D. course work, is required to submit the RAC report after completion of six months on and from the date of their enrolment.
- 2. A candidate is required to submit Ph. D. thesis within six months on and from the delivery of pre-submission seminar. However, if a candidate fails to submit the thesis within the stipulated time period as stated then the candidate has to deliver the seminar once again. If, during the delivery of pre-submission seminar, the research scholar is asked by the open forum to make any addition or alteration which is according to the RAC, is an essential condition to complete the research work then the candidate is required to deliver a pre-submission seminar not earlier than three

months on and from the date of first pre-submission seminar. The RAC must send its recommendation to the research section regarding the above matter immediately.

All the processes as laid down herein to be completed and the thesis should be submitted within the time limit as provided in the BANKURA UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS RELATING TO DOCTORAL (Ph.D.) DEGREE, 2017.

- 3. After pre-submission seminar and before the submission of Ph. D. thesis, if the gap is six months on and from the last submission of RAC report then the candidate is required to submit RAC report further.
- 4. If any supervisor failed to present his/her scholar(s) before the RAC within the stipulated time period as per the university regulations/norms may intimate the same to the research section in writing describing the reason(s) for such failure so that the matter can be forwarded to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor to pass appropriate order.
