NOTIFICATION

In compliance with the memorandum bearing No. 120-F(P2) dated 04.01.2019 issued by Finance Department, Audit Branch, Govt. of West Bengal, it is hereby notified for information to all concerned that the University will remain open on 08-01-2019 & 09-01-2019. All sections of employees (teachers, officers and non-teaching employees) shall report for duty on that date and **no Casual leave for absence either in the first half of the day or in the second half or for the whole day nor any other leave** shall be granted to any employee on the said dates i.e. on 08-01-2019 & 09-01-2019. The employees who are on leave on 04-01-2019 shall have to report for duty on 07.01.2019, Besides the bandh days, no leave for the day preceding the bandh days i.e. 07-01-2019 and for the day following the bandh days i.e. 10-01-2019 shall be allowed. Absence of employees on that date will be treated as **dies non** and **no salary will be admissible unless such absence is covered by the following grounds:**

- a) Hospitalisation of the employee;
- b) Bereavement in the family;
- c) Severe illness and absence continuing prior to 04-01-2019;
- d) Employees who had been on Child Care Leave, Maternity Leave, Medical Leave and Earned Leave sanctioned prior to the 04-01-2019.

It should be remembered that dislocation/disruption of vehicular traffic will not be a reason for granting leave.

Where the absence is not covered by any of the above mentioned reasons and the leave has not been approved, the same will be treated as 'dies non' and no salary will be admissible for the above mentioned days.

All Heads/Controlling Officers are hereby requested to send department-wise absentee report on those days, as aforesaid within 1-30 p.m. If any employee remains absent on that date, he/she will be asked to explain why action would not be taken against him/her for such unauthorized absence. On receipt of satisfactory reply, leave due and admissible may be granted on production of documentary evidence on the ground mentioned above.

All sections of employees (teachers, officers and non-teaching employees) are directed to comply with the said order strictly.
