**BANKURA UNIVERSITY****Department of Sanskrit****Syllabus (CBCS)****B.A Honours in Sanskrit and B.A Program in Sanskrit****(6 Semesters Pattern)**

There will be six semesters in the three-year B.A. Honours in Sanskrit. The Curriculum consists of 14 Core Courses (C), 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), 2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SES) and 4 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses and 4 Generic Elective (GE) courses [to be taken from the pool of Generic Elective Courses]. Each course is of 50 marks. L stands for Lecture Hour, T for Tutorial Hour and P for Practical Hour.

1. 60% of Questions are to be answered compulsory in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 1st and 2nd Semester.

2. 80% of Questions are to be answered compulsory in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 3rd and 4th Semester.

3. 100% Questions are to be answered compulsory in Sanskrit with Devanagari script in 5th and 6th Semester.
