One paper on socio-political background of Santali literature and Units on socio-political background of Santali literature and Units on such background in individual papers are expected to provide knowledge on how to situate literary production in the larger context of socio-political history. Papers on texts from various phases and genres of Santali literature will introduce the student to the salient features of respective phases, features of respective genres and contribution of individual authors. Understanding of the idea of research will be nurtured through the course on Research Methodology and guided dissertation writing.
