**Semester –V****Major Course: 10****Course Code: A/SNS/502/MJC-10****Course Title: Sanskrit Grammar and Linguistics****Credit – 4, Marks – 50**

Objectives: This paper introduces *kāraṇaprakaraṇa* from *Sidhāntakaumudī* and also gives an introduction to Linguistics based on Sanskrit. Sanskrit has great influence over comparative philology and later it is transformed into linguistics. Sanskrit has lot of materials for studying linguistics.

Course Learning Outcome: *Sidhāntakaumudī* of BhaṭṭojīDīkṣita is the celebrated grammar text of sixteen century. *Kāraṇa* theory is the key concept of Sanskrit grammar. Without knowing it is impossible to write sentence in Sanskrit. Here students will know about some selected rules of Pāṇini along with the commentary of BhaṭṭojīDīkṣita. The students will learn about how sentence are constructed in Sanskrit language through *kāraṇa* theory. Students will also learn about language families, especially about Indo-European language family. They would also learn about phonetic changes, semantic changes etc.

Objectives: In this paper different ancient inscriptions and scripts are included. These are integral parts of Sanskrit Literature and important source of history. Though the inscriptions of emperor Aśoka are in Prākṛt, but they are the first written evidence of the subcontinent, other than the Indus valley civilisation. But without them neither Sanskrit literature nor Indian history is completed.

Course Learning Outcome: Students will learn Brāhmī script. They will study selected Prākṛt inscriptions and Sanskrit inscription in Brāhmī script, except Bilāśdev's inscription.

Course Title: Internship Paper

1. Internship Categories:

1.1 Internship for enhancing the employability:

- The students may be engaged in any institution (as mentioned above) to develop their confidence for future work.
- The students may be trained to build a sense of coordination in a team to achieve success in doing different types of project work.
- The students may be called on to attend workshop at their colleges to acquire the knowledge of ethical values to fabricate unthreatened future.
- The students may be coached for – online Sanskrit course: create video, lectures, Podcasts, teaching Sanskrit language, literature and culture.
- College can provide translation services for individuals or businesses needing Sanskrit – to – English or Sanskrit – to Sanskrit translation.

- preparing a bibliography or several citation styles for future research.
- assembling work experience with Peers, mentors or experts from other disciplines to ensure methodological rigor and validity.
- keeping detailed records of research design, methods and findings.
- achieving the technique of communication research findings through presentations using clear and accessible language.

The students should be given a comprehensive guide for accomplishing their goal and success.

Duties of Internship:

During the internship, students are expected to:

- Observe and participate in the activities of the resource centre. / Different types of training programme provided by the colleges.
- Arranged seminar and presentation programme to communicate acquired knowledge, observation, insights, skills, work experience on a relevance topic.
- Prepare a report or research article based on internship experience.
- Obtain a certificate from the concerned authority upon completion of the internship.

Assessment:

The internship programme will be assessed based on:

- The quality of the report or research article submitted by the student.
- The certificate obtained from the concerned authority.
- The student's participation and engagement during the internship program.

By completing this internship programme, students will gain valuable practical experience and skills and can prepare themselves for a successful career in Sanskrit studies and research.
