Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The set of measures taken in Bankura University to complete the syllabus of courses and programs is very much timely and effective. The measures are designed in such a manner that it becomes very much handy to students. Interests of the students are given the maximum precedence, so that the measures to be used for the smooth and effective teaching-learning process becomes vastly helpful for the students. The University has its fully functional Digital Resource System (https://bkudigiresources.eazyclasses.com/bkuecls/), the hyperlink of which is categorically available in the institutional website. Through such a wonderful platform, all the teachers of this University can upload their series of study materials and lectures as per their plans and consequently it becomes available exclusively to the students through the institutional website. Students, using their own credential, can access the materials exclusively meant for them and hence get largely benefitted. The initiative of the University to introduce the University Learning Management System (ULMS) in the form of its Digital Resources is a splendid effort to develop and successfully implement the concept of e-Classroom. As the tools for ICT-enabled teaching-learning process, teachers of this University relentlessly use various online resources in the form of e-Books and e-Journals, National Digital Library, platforms like SWAYAM and NPTEL, numerous external e-Resources (e.g., South Asian Archive, Jstor, Project Muse, ProQuest, WBDSPACE, CORE, ScienceOpen, Paperity, Dryad, Ethos, DART Europe, etc.). Standard platforms like Google Meet, Cisco WebEx, ZOOM are widely used by the teachers for conducting classes in online mode and with active participation of students in such virtual mode, these sessions acquire wide acceptance to the students. Multiple digital repositories for lectures are fruitfully used while delivering lectures. Teachers are well equipped with tools like desktops and laptops, projectors, digital cameras, printers, photocopiers, tablets, pen drives, scanners, microphones, DVDs, CDs. The Classrooms and Seminar Halls are equipped with LCD/LED projectors and the Internet connectivity. The Departments of the University are equipped with laptops to enable the teachers to teach with the aid of PPTs and other technical tools like cinematography, videos, photographs, charts, etc. The Departments also are equipped either with Wi-Fi or cable network facility. Departments of the University possess own computers with the Internet connectivity for the use of students. The University successfully conducts the Examination System in online mode and by maintaining the full confidentiality in the assessment process, does publish the result in a very timely manner. Apart from having in use such modern amenities for the teaching-learning system and the evaluation process, the Library of this University is automated using the most popular open source Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) known as KOHA, which is a 100% browser based open source ILMS with all data being stored in cloud using secure AWS cloud server. Students of this University enjoy the liberty to access the Library collections in 24x7 basis through OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue). In this way, Bankura University takes all possible necessary measures to have a timely completion of covering of its courses and programs.</p>
